Institute Distinctiveness – AY2023-2024

The Centers of Excellence (CoE) achieved remarkable milestones during the 2023-24 period, driven by its mission to empower learners with contemporary competencies through state-of-the-art learning spaces and proven processes for sustainable growth and development.

To meet diverse learning needs, the CoEs offered 76 courses and 88 programs, benefiting 3,799 students from MCET and NPTC, along with 271 students from other institutions, reinforcing their commitment to quality education.

Under the PMKVY 4.0 scheme, 240 students were trained in roles such as EV Service Technicians, CNC Operators (Vertical Milling), Draftsman (Mechanical), and Assembly Line Operators, generating INR 24 lakhs in fees. An MoU with Tamil Nadu Apex Skill Development Corporation facilitated Lean Six Sigma certification for 40 students, including 5 Black Belts and 35 Green Belts.

The CoEs also contributed to industry skill enhancement. Training in Welding and NDT at the TUV Rheinland Centre enabled 121 unemployed youth to secure jobs, while behaviour change programs benefitted 60 welders from Propel Industries and 23 employees from Revathi Equipment Ltd.

Sixty final-year students trained for Product Lifecycle Management (PLM) roles, securing 23 job offers. Additionally, 26 students completed PLM internships at the Siemens Centre for Digital Manufacturing.
